Closing the DS200



AFTER THE LAST VOTER LEAVES THE BUILDING,

If there are any ballots in the Emergency bin

A bipartisan team will remove the strap seal & unlock Emergency bin & scan the ballots.


If a screen message other than the ballot counted appears, eject ballot and place in the Green Unscanned Security Bag.
Account for it on the Seals Report



Remove the sticker seal from the access door by the printer.


Place used seal in **Red** Data Bag





Using the barrel key, open the door

Press the CLOSE POLL button only




Screen prompts you to 'Close Poll.'



2-Results tapes will print

Be patient. This may take a few minutes as the DS200 tabulates the results





Place in Red Data Bag




Read off Results

After reading (and signing), place in the **Red** Data Bag




Affix second tape to wall or table

Before leaving polling location, remove and place in **Red Data Bag**



DS200 displays the following message:

Select 'Finished – Turn Off'



DS200 powers down



Wait till the screen turns black



Wait until the Power Light goes off.

DO NOT PRESS
THE POWER
BUTTON!



Bipartisan team removes the USB Flash Drive <u>after</u> Power Light goes off



USB Flash Drive is NEVER removed during the day.
It is removed ONLY at closing.




Place USB Flash Drive in inside pocket of Red Data Bag



Close and lock compartment with barrel key.

Remove a new sticker seal from Red Data Bag



Record and Seal the Compartment

Record number on Return of Canvass Seals Verification Report



Unlock wheels and turn the DS200 around. Using silver key, unlock the back door compartment.

Remove the plug from the electrical outlet.



Wrap cord neatly, using the Velcro that's attached to the cord and place back in the compartment



Using the silver key, lock the back compartment door



Turn DS200 around Bipartisan team breaks ballot door strap seal.


Place used seal in **Red** Data Bag



Using silver key, unlock the Ballot Compartment

Lower Blue Bin door flaps & remove Tote Bin





- Place the unused Ballot Pads and Ballot Pad stubs inside the Blue Tote Bin
- Lock doors on Blue Tote bin using the silver key



Remove a strap seal from the Red Data Bag and put it through the Blue Bin hinges

Record strap seal number on Return of Canvass Seals Verification Report



Place Blue Tote bin back inside the Ballot Compartment of the DS200

Place Extension
Cord (if one was
used) and Privacy
panels on top of bin



Take 2 strap seals from Red Data Bag

Lock & Seal Ballot Compartment Door &

Emergency Ballot Bin Door

Record numbers on Return of Canvass Seals Verification Report



Gently lower the monitor of the DS200



Using the Barrel key, lock the DS200 monitor in place



Lower the lid on the DS200.
Clasp it down.

Take a strap seal from Red

Data Bag and place

through clasp opening

Record number on Return of Canvass Seals Verification Report




Using the silver key, lock the front lid of the DS200


The DS200 is now ready for transport



Take the keys (silver key and barrel key) and place inside the Red Data Bag




Complete the Return of Canvass Report



Bipartisan Team signs the Return of Canvass Report





Remove 4 tab seals from the Red Data Bag

(one for each of the bags: Green, Orange, Blue & Red)

Record seal numbers from zipper end and slot end on the Seals Verification Report



Taking the tab seal place it through the slot of each of the Security bags as shown

(even if the bags are empty).



Once the Return of Canvass is complete & signed place it inside the Red Data Bag



Use the final tab seal to seal to seal the Red Data bag by slipping the seal into the slot of the clasp by the zipper



Gather all the other supplies and place back in the Blue Bag





Blue Bag and Red Data Bag are to be returned to the police precinct.

DO NOT put the Red Data Bag inside the Blue Bag

Show the Poll Coordinator the Red Data Bag with the flash drive visible from the front pocket before leaving the poll site
